Please Help Linus

Linus, one of our rhesus macaques, was taken to the veterinarian last week due to his sleepy eyed look and lack of energy. The prognosis is not good. Linus has a severely enlarged heart that is pressing against one lung, cutting off his oxygen supply. Linus was noticeably losing weight at the time he was taken in to see Dr. Maness. Dr. Maness who is here from San Antonio, Texas, is an exotic vet with many hours of primate experience. The clinic is just 1/2 miles from us, so it is a great find!

Linus' congestive heart disease will take its toll, but in the mean time, we are going to try bronchial expansion meds on him. We will also give him heart meds to slow the pace of the disease. Not a cure, but at least it beats the alternative, being euthanized. If Linus starts coughing or has lung congestion, then and only then, will we release him from future suffering. Keep your fingers crossed for this little guy, he is just seven years of age....

Linus's medical treatment has cost over \$300 and the future meds will be an added expense. Please consider making a donation to help us care for Linus. He deserves to live.
